King Edward VI College was founded in 1552 one of top A Level Colleges in the Midlands, covering Stourbridge, Halesowen and Dudley areas.

The project included alterations and refurbishments to school buildings during the summer period. Works included demolition of classroom walls, formation of new classroom and staff areas, all mechanical and electrical items, flooring, false ceilings and decorations.

The planned phasing of the project was critical in order that parts of the site could be kept operational during the summer term. We provided a full time working foreman dedicated to the project who liaised daily with the Site Manager to minimise disruption to the school and neighbours to site.

The project was completed within the 8 week programme originally planned and the final account value was within the Clients Budget, even though various additional items of work had been included.
