Contract details

Cardiff and Vale University Health Board is one of the largest NHS organisations in Wales providing health services to around 478,000 people living in Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan. The University Hospital of Wales is a 1,000 bed hospital in the Heath district of Cardiff and a teaching hospital for Cardiff University.

Over six months, Ian Williams completed a number of internal and external decorations and associated repairs to various areas within the hospital including

- Painting of the external canopy of the Dialysis Unit
- Decoration to covered walkways linking the hospital buildings
- Painting of the hospital's plant room
- Creation of line marking to various tunnels underneath the hospital to create safe pathways for staff

Before works began in the hospital, all operatives were DBS checked and completed a specialist site induction which included the hospital's policies and procedures as well as information for working around patients.

Ian Williams completed the majority of the works out of hours minimising disruption to patients and staff. This included painting lines in the tunnels at night when they were unused by staff and working at weekends to paint the canopy.

All works were carried out by our directly employed Cardiff workforce.
