Established last year, the Ian Williams' Foundation is an employee led team that manages the funding we provide for community investment, charitable donations and supports voluntary work nationally.

The value equivalent of the foundation's work exceeds £100,000. In the short time that the Foundation has been operational, over £3,800 in donations has been awarded to worthwhile causes.

These include:

Dynamite Street Dance Crew

The young dance squad has successfully qualified for the European and World Street Dance competitions in Germany and Glasgow. The cost of getting the dancers and support network to these locations for the duration of the competitions is over £15,000 which is why we're delighted to have made a donation from the Foundation towards these costs.

Macmillan

As a specialist oncology pharmacist, Hollie Turner has seen first hand the impact that cancer has on individuals and their families and friends. Hollie and her friend decided to run



the Bath Half Marathon to raise money for Macmillan. The Foundation made a donation of £150 towards her fundraising target.

MIND

Nottingham's Painting Surveyor, Elliot Brown is in training for the Nottingham Half Marathon which takes place in September. Elliot is raising money for MIND, after seeing his girlfriend's father pass away after a long running illness and battle with mental health issues. The Foundation donated £250.

Bounce Back

Bounce Back is a charity and social enterprise focused on training and employment of ex-offenders. They have set up a small business to train individuals from Brixton Prison in 3 separate works services, one of which is painting. Ian Williams' painting team in London have been working closely with Bounce Back to provide buddying/ mentoring to help the process between training and going out into the real world.
