## Contract details

The Whitgift School forms part of the Whitgift Foundation and is a private boys' school based in South London. The school was established in 1600, making it the oldest school in Croydon.

We undertook internal and external works to various buildings on the school's grounds, including the chapel, teachers' accommodation and a school hall. Works included full decorations, kitchen installation and flooring.

The Chapel and school hall were regularly used by pupils and staff and therefore we had to programme these works during school holidays to prevent any disruption during term time. Works undertaken in teachers' accommodation were also carried out under strict unmovable deadlines, as new staff were moving into the houses at the start of the new term.

We had to work closely with the school's own maintenance team, who were delivering Mechanical & Electrical works, including close liaison with their electricians to ensure programme completion.

We developed the specification in partnership with supply chain partner PPG Industries and advised Whitgift on the most appropriate, cost effective products.

Although the school managed customer liaison processes, including recording colour choices, our dedicated Site Supervisor was on site at all times to answer any queries from staff and pupils.
