Founded in 1896 Clayesmore School is a co-educational independent school for pupils aged 3-18. In 1933 the School moved to its current 62-acre site in the village of Iwerne Minster, Dorset. Around 700 pupils attend across the preparatory and senior schools.

Ian Williams undertook a number of internal and external redecoration and flooring projects to a variety of buildings across the School's campus including;

- The Headmaster's and Housemaster's Houses
- Drama Theatre
- Pupil dormitories
- Junior and Senior sports changing rooms
- Administrative offices
- Corridors and staircases

Two key challenges of this project were working to tight timescales and meeting the needs of a changing programme during the summer holidays. Our flexible approach to planning and programming facilitated by our directly employed, local workforce ensured that all works were completed on time and to specification.

During the summer holidays the School hosted various residential camps for over 500 young people. All of our directly employed team working on site had Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and received training on working in and around occupied educational buildings ensuring the safety of the youngsters.
